

Basically, if you have 12 people who care, you are on your way to start Reality Tour and fill your volunteer roster.

Once you have presented several programs, volunteers will be familiar with a number of roles and can multi-task. In the initial stage each volunteer only needs to understand their duty.

It is important to have 2 Reality Tour Directors who serve as emcee and present the power point and conduct the interviews. You may have additional directors who only want behind the scenes organizing tasks.

For acting roles, note that the scenes are very brief and professional or little theater actors are not required, but certainly would be welcome. Most Reality Tours fill acting roles using persons without experience.

The Reality Tour Program Model includes written description of all roles as well as a video training. It will take just four 90-minute training sessions to train volunteers. Each session is detailed in the Program Manual.

TIP: Volunteer signup forms should request a 6-month volunteer commitment along with contact information.

Youth Volunteer Roles

Group of Youth (4-6) Mix of ages. Peer Pressure 4 min skit (optional)	(45 min)
Teen Actor (1) – M/F Appear to be 18. Scenes: Arrest, Jail, ER	(90 min)
Teen Actors (2) Friends of afflicted teen in ER & Funeral scenes. (optional)	(90 min)
Youth (1-2) Morph digital photos using software (optional)	(2 hrs.)
Youth in Recovery *– Interview during program	(90 min)

*Youth is ideal. If not accessible opt for parent/s of youth afflicted by substance abuse.

Adult Volunteer Roles

Adults (2) Tour Directors**– Serve as spokesperson to present program	(3 hrs)
Adult (1-2) – IT duties for equipment set up & function	(3 hrs)
Adult Actors Parent/s Role – Scenes: ER. Funeral	(90 min)
Adult Actors Friends of Parent/s Role – Scenes: ER, Funeral (Optional)	(90 min)

Adult Actors (1-3)– EMT, ER doctor/nurse role – Scene: ER	(90 min)
Adult Actor – Brief arrest scene. Portray undercover officer	(1 hr)
Adults/Teens (1-3) Registration check-in	(45 min)
Adult/Teen Group Leaders (4-6) Guide groups & Assist Tour Director	(2 hrs.)
Law Enforcement or School Resource Officer – Interviewed on local trends	(45 min)

**Tour Directors have preparation and wrap up duties in addition to program time.

NOTE: All volunteers are tapped for set up and tear down or assemble a special team.
